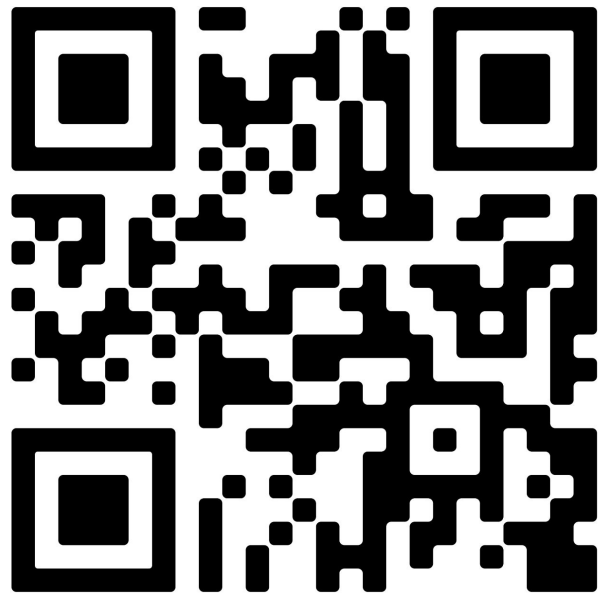
Review feedback from large energy users and other stakeholders.
